Meeting called to order by **Terry**.

OLD BUSINESS

Discussion: **Terry** opened the discussion by revisiting one of the most critical and yet basic rules of the club. **Terry** emphasized how important it is that all pilots flying conventional aircraft, powered and soaring gliders, and multirotor ships, fly within the physical boundaries of the field. The potential for personal injury, and property damage is highly probable, not to mention loosing the privilege of use of the field by the city.

Terry also reminded members to call out to the flying member if there is someone on the field, or if there is a low flying full scale aircraft. Also discussed was member courtesy. Generally the first person to arrive at the field has the option of flying first. This holds true as each member arrives. The pilot who is in line to fly, may make it known that he intends to pass his turn to the next pilot in line. Finally, it was discussed that the plane stands are for pre-flight and post-flight preparations. The pilot should remove his aircraft from the stand as soon as possible, unless repairs are needed.

NEW BUSINESS

Treasury Report: **Romeo** reported that there is currently \$5017.55 in the account. A check was written for \$24.71 to **Jerry** for gate lock replacement. Bringing total to \$4992.84.

Jerry introduced prospective members **Ed Jones**, and **Angelo Lopez**. **Jerry** advised that **Angelo** and **Ed** are both “Open” members of the AMA. **Angelo** has an AMA number, and **Ed** is waiting for his card to be mailed. Both proofs of AMA membership have been visually verified. Also, **Ed** and **Angelo** have demonstrated that they can control their quadcopters safely, and within the field boundaries.

As there was no further new business or discussions, the meeting was adjourned.
