## **NEW BUSINESS**

Club Treasurer **Romeo** gave a report on the clubs financial status. There is currently \$5005.71 in the club's account. There were no expenditures or income this month.

**Discussion: Terry** discussed an email that **Jerry** received regarding the visit of AMA District Vice President, Kris Dixon. Mr. Dixon is on vacation in the area and wanted to visit the local RC Clubs. His agenda dedicated Thursday and Friday of next week for a visit. **Jerry** responded by letting him know that almost all O.B.R.C.C. Members would not be available on those days. Mr. Dixon will be visiting the Flagler Club.

**Discussion:** Terry brought up the discussion on club T-shirts. **Roger** has spearheaded the printing of club T-shirts. **Jerry** received a group of 5 prospective designs from Terry. Terry advised that the format of the designs was not compatible with the process of transferring the design to a shirt. Terry further advised that it would take someone with a special skill to convert that design to the proper format, and this could result in an additional fee. Lets put the ordering of T-shirts on the back burner until it can be determined if the process can be accomplished at all, and at what cost. The proofs for the logo designs were sent to **Roger** only as an illustration of what the club decided on.

**Discussion: Steve** brought up that the multi-rotor pilots should continue to fly in the southeast area of the field. **Terry** mentioned that some of the pilots with the larger, faster aircraft may need to use a portion of the southeast area of the field to slow down for approach and landing. We all just need to observe caution and courtesy when flying. Multi-rotor pilots may use the north section of the field but for the courtesy of waiting pilots, pre-flight and repairs should be completed prior to taking a turn in the north area.
